2024 Bonnie Price Holloman Scholarship Qualifications



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- A. The Association shall fund eight \$2000 scholarships this year.
- B. Employees, children, and grandchildren of full-time employees of active members of the Southeastern Grain & Feed Association will be eligible.
- C. Eligible candidates must be enrolled as a student in an accredited college or technical school seeking a minimum level of associate degree.
- D. Candidate shall be enrolled as a minimum second year student with no less than a 2.5 GPA.
- E. This scholarship will be given under and Equal Opportunity situation with no discrimination as to race, gender, religion, or age.
- F. Payment of scholarship will be directly to the school for use by the recipient.
- G. Selection of the Scholarship recipient will be decided by the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors or such other committees appointed by the Board.
- H. Candidates will fill out an application form, available from your personnel office, and will also be required to write a brief essay. (We encourage you to complete the application online at segfa.org) The essay should be an original composition written exclusively for entry in the Southeastern Grain & Feed Association Scholarship Program. The essay should be no less than 350 words and no more than 700 words, typed and double spaced.
- I. Selection will be based on information from the applicant with consideration given to the field of study, goals, family and social activities, content, and quality of the essay.
- J. Applications are due into the Association office by June 20, 2024.
